RE: Developmental Screening

The Port Washington-Saukville School District will be holding developmental screenings of three- and four-year-old children. If parents feel their child is developing comparatively well, it is not necessary to have them screened at this time. Following are the screening dates for the 2024-2025 school year:

Thursday, September 19, 2024  
Wednesday, January 15, 2025

Please call Student Services at 262-268-6079 to make an appointment. The screenings will be scheduled by appointment only on each date.

Parents who have a child who seems to be behind other children in development are strongly encouraged to bring their child to this screening. There have been many studies which have proven that the earlier a concern is addressed the less severe it will be after a child starts school.

If a child is found to have difficulties that interfere with learning, we would determine if a child has an impairment which requires special educational programming. There are a number of types of impairments, including the following: speech impairment, learning disability, visual disability, hearing impairment, physical disability, autism, and developmental delay. Those children who qualify will be able to participate in our district's early childhood program. The screening, subsequent testing, and enrollment in the early childhood program are offered at no cost to parents.
