



## Port Washington-Saukville School District Chromebook Insurance 2024-25

### What is the PWSSD Chromebook Insurance program?

Accidental Drop/Damage Insurance is being offered by the Port Washington-Saukville School District. This coverage will protect you in the event that a school issued device is damaged due to drops, power surges and breakage. If enrolled, this coverage starts when the payment is made and ends on the last day of school (or until the start of the new school year if you were given permission to keep your Chromebook during the summer).

What is Covered? Unintentional damages such as:	What is NOT Covered? Damage caused by intentional acts, fire, theft or loss.
Drops, falls, and other collisions	Damaged in a fire or flood (home insurance coverage)
Electrical power surge	Intentional damage/Vandalism (user responsible)
Damaged or broken LCD due to a drop/fall/pressure	Lost Chromebook (user responsible)
Accidental breakage (multiple pieces)	Power cord damage or loss (user responsible)
Liquid spilled on or in unit	Removal of keys from keyboard (user responsible)
** Repair or replacement of devices is up to the discretion of the Technology Department. **	

How much does this insurance cost?	\$10 (Grades 1-6) / \$25 (Grades 7-12) to enroll in the program, PLUS:
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. For each <b>unintentional damage (Covered) claim</b>, deductibles will be charged per the below schedule.</li> <li>B. For any <b>non-covered claims</b>, full price of the repair will be charged.</li> </ul>
1st occurrence/claim	No deductible, full coverage
2nd/3rd occurrence/claim	\$20 deductible if repair cost is greater than \$75
4th+ occurrence/claim	\$20 deductible
